PRESENT: Mayor Skinner; Kim Crupper; Greg Middleton; Bob Perry; Matthew Smith; Ken Stone; Amanda Winters; Jeff Shipp; and Vivian Link

ALSO PRESENT: Cheyene Miller (Grant Co. News) and Jamey Rhoton (Grant County Fair Board)

Mayor Skinner called the meeting to order.

Grant County Fair Grounds: Discussion of Ending Times for Events

Jamey Rhoton was present representing Grant County Fair Board. He stated his request was to add an extra hour on various Truck/Tractor Pulls. Mr. Rhoton stated they would start events earlier to comply with the current Ordinance. But there are still certain events that the extra hour is needed. Discussion occurred on how to handle these situations. Amanda Winters suggested requesting a permit on the few events the extra hour would be needed. Jeff Shipp stated this could be possible and a permit could be issued on a case to case basis. Guidelines would have to be implemented as well as an appeal process.

Council requested Jeff Shipp to amend the current Noise Ordinance and have it on the agenda at the next Council Meeting for review.

First Reading of Ordinance 2017-05, Cable Rates Ordinance Amendment

As directed by Council, Jeff Shipp gave the First Reading of Ordinance 2017-05, Cable Rates Ordinance Amendment, in summary. There were many changes addressed in the Amendment. Discussion occurred on the increasing cost of Royalty Fees. Bob Perry expressed concern on the cost of fiber repair being to cheap. Further discussion occurred.

First Reading of Ordinance 2017-06, Cemetery Rates (Burial, Grave Plot Charges)

As directed by Council, Jeff Shipp gave the First Reading of Ordinance 2017-06, Cemetery Rates (Burial, Grave Plot Charges), in summary. Changes in Burial and/or Grave Plots were increased as well as the cost of opening and closing graves.

City Council Consideration/Approval of Pumping Station Equipment Request for Bid

There was one bid received for the Pumping Station Equipment. The bid was received from Smith & Loveless, Inc. in the amount of \$60,000.

Ken Stone made the motion approving Smith & Loveless, Inc., bid in the amount of \$60,000 for Pumping Station Equipment. Bob Perry seconded the motion, and the vote was as follows:

Stop Light at Intersection of North Main Street and Baton Rouge Road (in Front of Ruler Foods and Tractor Supply) - Discussion

Discussion occurred on the Stop Light at the above referenced intersection. The Traffic Light has been under study for approximately two years. It was stated that the State Highway Department is wanting to close the Barnes Road intersection to US 25. If this was to happen, the Traffic Light at North Main and Baton Rouge would be needed. Also discussion happened on the condition of the roads at both intersections. It was suggested to do a Resolution or letter be sent to the State Road Department recommending the activation of the Stop Light at the intersection of North Main Street and Baton Rouge Road.

Amanda Winters made the motion to approve a Resolution or Letter be sent to the State Highway Department requesting the reactivation of the Stop Light at the Intersection of North Main Street and Baton Rouge Road. Greg Middleton seconded the motion, and the vote was as follows:
